Thank you for considering Adopting a Cabin at the Cashmere Museum! We ask that you sign and return page 2 of these guidelines to the Museum if you, as an individual, family, group, or organization would like to adopt a cabin.

ADOPT A CABIN GUIDELINES

- 1. Choose the cabin you would like to adopt.
- 2. Cleaning of the cabins takes place prior to March when the Museum opens, in June for Founders' Day, and late September before Apple Days.
- 3. Jobs include wiping down the walls, washing curtains, doilies, and other linen items. Washing display dishes, dusting lamp fixture and knick-knacks as needed. Sweep or vacuum the floor, and clean any windows.
- 4. If you find any structural repairs to be completed, or damaged items, contact Museum Staff and discuss with them what needs to be done. The Staff will take the information to the Board for a decision about the work. Your group is welcome to provide funds to make repairs, but it is not required.
- 5. Cabins are to be kept as original as possible with reference give to the time it was originally used: paint, wallpaper, furniture, décor should reflect the history of the cabin.
- 6. No items are to be taken out of the cabins except to clean them, or if they are broken turn them in to Staff. The Museum kitchen in the lower level has water available for cleaning. Please let the Museum Staff know of any items you may be taking home to clean, and also when you return them.
- 7. You will be notified of the dates of 'cleaning parties', but make arrangements with the Staff if you will be doing cleaning or repair work at other times so that the cabin can be opened for you.
- 8. Lock the cabin when you leave, and check out at the office so we can log your volunteer time.
- Light weeding in the gardens around your cabin is appreciated. The gardens are kept mulched to preserve moisture and prevent weeds. If you need to water around the cabin, take care not to get any water on the cabin, as it causes moisture damage over time.
