Thank you for considering Adopting a Cabin at the Cashmere Museum!
Below are the cabin guidelines.

Adopt a Cabin Guidelines

1. Choose the cabin your club, organization, or individual would like to adopt.
2. Cleaning of the cabins take place mainly in March when the museum opens, in June for Founders' Day, and late September before Apple Days.
3. Jobs to be done are wiping down the walls, washing curtains, doilies, and other linen items. Washing dishes (occasionally), dusting lamp fixtures, and other knick-knacks in the cabins as needed. Sweep or vacuum the floor as needed.
4. If there is any structural repair to be completed, contact museum staff and discuss with them what you would like to do. Museum staff will bring the information to the board if needed to discuss and make a decision about the work.
5. Cabins are to be kept as original as possible with reference given to the time line that cabin projects. ie: painting, furniture, décor should match the time in history of that cabin.
6. No items are to be taken out of the cabins except to clean. Washing of some items can be completed in the museum kitchen in the lower level of the museum. If linens need to be taken home to wash, please let the museum staff know what items you are taking and when the items are returned.

7. Let the museum know ahead of time when you will be doing cleaning or repair work to make sure someone is available to open the cabin for you.
8. Lock the cabin when you leave, and check out at the office so we can log your volunteer time.
9. Light weeding is appreciated, and the gardens are kept mulched to preserve moisture and prevent weeds. If you need to water around the cabins, take care not to get any water on the cabins themselves.
- 10 .If at some point your group decides you no longer wish to take care of the cabin, let the museum know. Call (509) 782-3230.
